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Supplementary Figure 1. Crabp1 expression in spinal neurons. Confocal microscopy images showing signals of CRABP1 (Green), general neuronal marker

- 16 NeuN (Red), and cell nuclei (DAPI). White arrows mark NeuN+/Crabp1- cells,
- 17 indicating subsets of Crabp1-negative spinal neurons. Scale bar = 50 um.
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Supplementary Figure 2. Quantification of Crabp1-positive spinal motor neurons. Data of Fig. 1b, from multiple sections, are quantified to determine the ratio of Crabp1+/ChAT+ cells in the lumbar spinal section, N = 4. The result is presented as means ± SEM. The result shows that greater than 95% of spinal motor neurons are Crabp1-positive.
