


Figure S1. Details about sources of sexual information. (A) In 37% of cases information about sex came from parents and teachers, in 25% from friends, in 15% from the internet, in 16% from books and 7% of the students did not want to specify the source of their information; (B) Communication with parents was considered excellent by 27% of the students, good by 43%, moderate by 24%, and non-existent by 5%.
