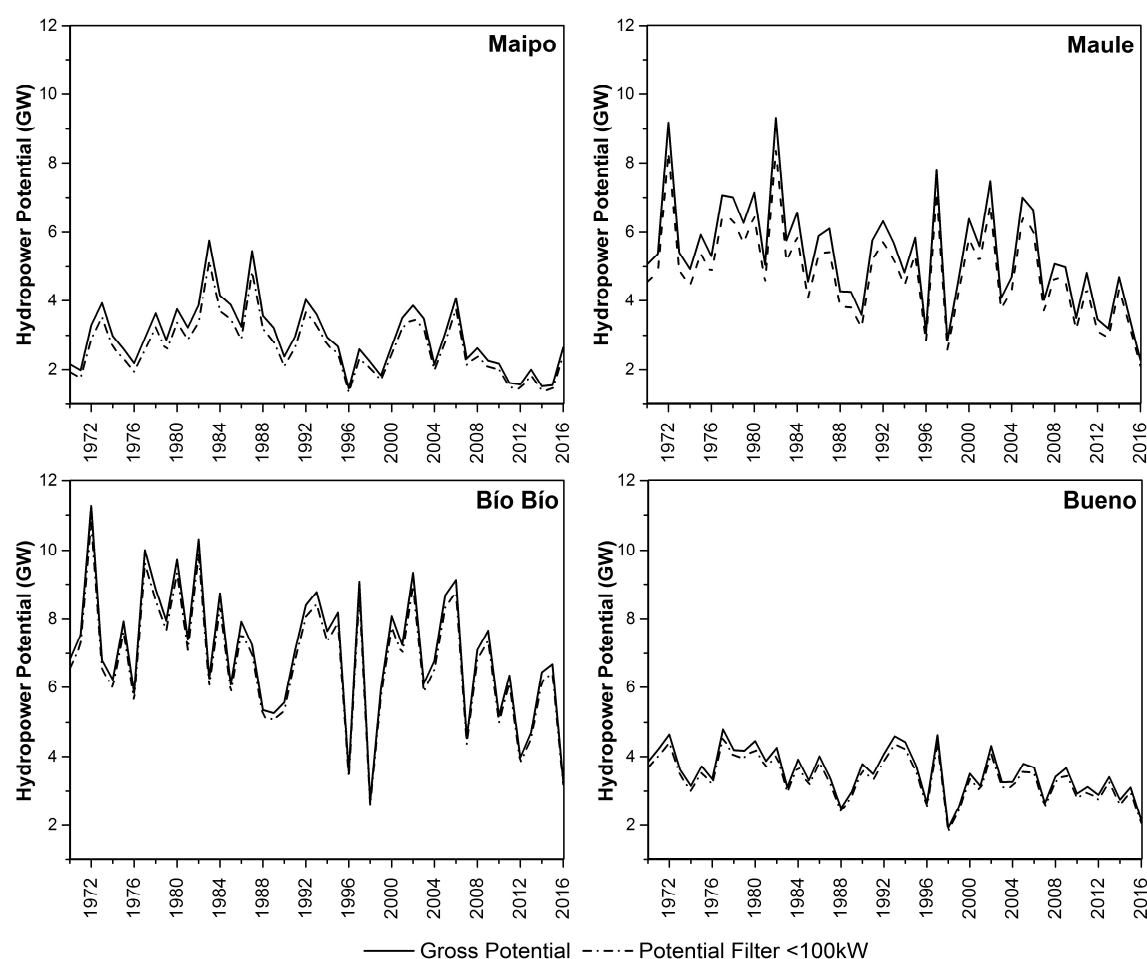


Figure S1. Effect of minimum power criterion on the annual hydropower potential in each basin.
