

**Figure S1.** Behavioral ratings for hunger **(A)**, satiety **(B)**, thirst **(C)** and taste cravings **(D)** in response to drink and concomitant standardized meal ingestion at T = 0 minute, indicated by a black arrow. A taste rating of 1 indicates the maximum preference for a salty item whereas 9 indicates the maximum preference for a sweet item. Data are presented as mean  $\pm$  SEM. <sup>a, b</sup>: p<0.05 for post-hoc paired t-tests (two-tailed), respectively between SUC-WAT and SUC-NNS.
