

Table S3. Specific exclusion criteria for each type of ulcer

<b>Pressure-ulcer patients</b>
Ulcers whose main cause is urinary or fecal incontinence.
Without willingness and/or availability of caregivers to follow care guidelines during the study.
<b>Venous leg-ulcer patients</b>
History of venous surgery in previous two months.
Episodes of venous thrombosis in previous three months.
History of intermittent claudication in previous three months.
Absence of posterior tibial and/or pedal pulse in extremity where ulcer was located.
Ankle-brachial index (ABI) <0.8 in previous six months.
Patient and/or caregivers unwilling and/or unavailable to allow daily use of compression bandage for the duration of the study.
<b>Diabetic- foot patients</b>
Not diagnosed with type 1 or 2 diabetes mellitus.
Ulcer with Charcot arthropathy (neuropathic arthropathy).
Absence of posterior tibial and/or pedal pulse in extremity where ulcer was located.
Ankle-brachial index (ABI) <0.8 in previous six months.
