2018 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD IN BIOSCIENCES AND BIOENGINEERING

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Received a Ph.D. degree within the past 10 years involved in the fields of applied biosciences and bioengineering.
- Is 35 years of age or under (as of 31 October 2018)
- Received a Ph.D. degree within the past 10 years involved in the fields of applied biosciences and bioengineering. <http://www.mdpi.com/journal/applsci/about>.
- Priority will be given to applicants who publish papers in *Applied Sciences* in 2018.

List of Documents for Application:

- A detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher’s own research grants.
- A scanned copy of one’s doctorate certificate.
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The award will consist of the following:

- 1500 Swiss Francs for the winner.
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in *Applied Sciences* after peer review.
- An engraved plaque.

We welcome nominations and applications for this award until **30 November 2018**.

Nomination and application materials of eligible candidates should be submitted with the subject via the link (<http://www.mdpi.com/journal/applsci/awards>). The winner will be announced in the middle of **January 2019**.
