#### FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND PhD STUDENTS

### Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must be a PhD student (within 4 years of receiving the PhD degree) or a postdoctoral fellow.
- 2. The candidate will attend an international conference between 1 March and 30 November 2018 (oral presentation or poster). Preference will be given to oral presentations accompanied by a published paper in the conference proceedings.
- 3. Awardees are asked to acknowledge support from the journal Electronics in their published papers or posters.

#### Applicants should provide:

- 1. The applicant's oral or poster abstract for the conference (list the conference name and its website).
- 2. CV, including a complete list of publications.
- 3. A justification letter (max. 500 words) describing the focus of their research, and what benefits the applicant could get from attending the conference.
- 4. A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words) from a supervisor or PI (Principal Investigator). The supervisor or PI should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all requirements.
