Cardiotonic steroids (CS), obtained from plants such as *Digitalis purpurea* and *Strophanthus*, and animals such as toad *Bufo Marinus*, were once widely used components of traditional medicine. The use of CS ouabain by Skou in the discovery of Na/K-ATPase consolidated the function of CS as inhibitors and regulators of Na/K-ATPase, opening a new era in the studies of these steroidal agents.
