Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. Applicants must be PhD graduate students, and postdoctoral fellows involved in mycology research.
- 2. Applicants will attend an international conference related to mycology research in 2018 and present their research (poster or oral presentation) during the event.
- 3. Required Application Documents:
  - Curriculum Vitae, including a complete list of publications.
  - Abstract of current and future work that will be
  - presented at the conference (around 500 words).

— Justification letter indicating the conference that the applicant wishes to attend, costs, and institutional support that will be provided.

- Recommendation letter from his/her mentor or PI.
- After the meeting, the awardee is requested to provide a copy
- of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/
- presentation and meeting badge that verifies his/her attendance.

The Award will consist of **800 CHF** and an Award Certificate. The fees can be used for registration, travel, or accommodation.
