## 2017 TRAVEL AVVARDS FOR POSTDOCS, MD AND PHD STUDENTS

## Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. Applicants must be PhD students, MDs, and PhD (or equivalent) postdoctoral fellows (who completed the PhD within the last two years).
- 2. The candidate must show that he/she is performing research in basic, translational or clinical medicine or biomedicine, health improvement strategies or clinical epidemiology.
- 3. Applicants must show evidence that they will present their research (oral or poster presentation) in a conference held from October 2017 to June 2018.
- 4. Applicants should provide:
  - An abstract that will be submitted to the conference (conference format is acceptable).
  - Curriculum Vitae.
  - Justification letter indicating the conference that the applicant wishes to attend, costs, and institutional support that will be provided.
  - Letter of support from his/her mentor.
  - The awardee will be asked to acknowledge the support for the journal Medical Sciences during their presentation
  - After the meeting, the awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/presentation and meeting badge that verifies his/her attendance.

The award will consist of **600 Swiss Francs** (CHF), and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. Please submit your applications to medsci@mdpi.com or saez@mdpi.com before **31 July 2017**. The award will be granted by mid September 2017.
