This prize is established in honor of Prof. Tu Youyou, who won the 2015 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine. The deadline for nominations of the second Tu Youyou Award is 1 March 2018.

General information:

- The award is given biennially to recognise and reward excellence and innovation in the areas of natural product and medicinal chemistry.
- Nominees may nominate themselves or be nominated by a colleague or colleagues.
- The winner will be selected by a panel of distinguished Editorial Board members of Molecules.
- The winner will receive a cash honorarium of 3000 CHF and an engraved commemorative plaque.

TU YOUYOU AWARD

To nominate a candidate, submitter(s) should provide an application package containing the following items:

- Nominee's name and contact details (including e-mail address, institutional affiliation, and full postal address).
- An up-to-date CV for the nominee.
- A summary of the nominee's work (max. 5000 words), describing the originality of the nominee's research, significance of the work within the context of the advancement of natural products and/or medicinal chemistry research and quality of the nominee's publications.
- Although not mandatory, reference letters are welcome.
- Incomplete application packages will be rejected without further communication with the submitter(s), beyond a one-time reminder that information was missing.
