2017 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHERS

Candidates' Requirements:

- a. This award is open to postdoctoral fellows involved in research on insurance and financial risk management. There is no age limit, but post-docs should be within 3 years of award of their PhD.
- b. Will attend an international conference in the second half year of 2017 or first half year of 2018 (oral or poster presentations will both be considered).
- c. Applicants are required to submit the following documents:
 - Outline of current and future work, including an explanation of how the applicant will benefit from presenting their work at the conference (500 words).
 - CV, including a complete list of publications.
 - The details of the planned conference (which conference, where, when, etc...).
 - The submitted abstract.
 - A letter of recommendation from the supervisor or PI, with statement indicating post-docs eligibility.
- d. Preference will be given to applicants meeting one or two of the following requirements:
 - Have previously published papers or plan to publish in *Risks*.
 - Demonstrate a commitment to future research or a professional career in the field of insurance and financial risk management.

The award will be 800 CHF (Swiss Francs).
