As Editor-in-Chief of *Sensors*, I am pleased to announce the two winners of the 2017 Travel Awards sponsored by *Sensors*:

Travel Awards were granted to **Dr. Darren Turner**, Postdoctoral Research Fellow of University of Tasmania, and **Dr. Joana Rafaela Lara Guerreiro**, Postdoctoral Research Fellow of International Iberian Nanotechnology Laboratory. The awards consist of 800 Swiss Francs each to attend any academic conference during 2017.

Dr. Darren Turner's research has made significant contributions to the discipline of remote sensing through innovative the use of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) for mapping the environment in unprecedented detail. He developed image processing techniques to mosaic hundreds of overlapping UAS images into a single orthomosaic at high resolution and accuracy. **Dr. Joana Rafaela Lara Guerreiro** is an expert on synthesis, characterization and functionalization of nanomaterials. Her research involves the innovative autonomous electrical biosensor, synergistically assembled inside a passive direct methanol fuel cell for screening cancer biomarkers.
