Dear Colleagues,

This Special Issue will focus on infections associated with specific exposure to environmental factors, animals, and activities. Examples include all zoonoses, protozoan, and parasitic infections associated with human activities (consumption of specific food items and especially raw food, consumption of stream water, use of night soil in agriculture), infections associated with sports and leisure (swimming, spelunking, white water rafting, camping) and many others.

We are inviting our colleagues to submit original research articles, reviews, and case reports, which focus on how specific exposures are associated with the development of infectious diseases. Priority will be given to articles focusing on rare or tropical diseases, however we invite submissions for all types of infectious diseases, so long as exposure to a specific environmental factor or activity is a critical element to the development of the disease. For case reports, we ask that the specific activity that predisposed the patient to developing the infection is explored in detail.
