The Award has been granted to:

Dr. Rachel Denison, a neuroscientist and postdoctoral researcher from New York University, NY, USA, who is studying the role of attention in visual experience. She uses a combination of human fMRI, MEG, psychophysics, and computation in her research work. She will present her work “Voluntary Temporal Attention Affects the Rate and Timing of Microsaccades” at the forthcoming Vision Sciences Society Annual Meeting 2018. The Award consists of 500 Swiss Francs to support her attendance at this conference.
