Figure A1 below shows the coefficient of performance of the N80 turbine which data was used in the study. The Betz limit (0.59) theoretically expresses the maximum efficiency with which a wind turbine can extract power from wind flow through the blades. Although turbine efficiency varies with wind speed, a few studies on estimation/forecast errors and performance evaluations assume a constant Cp, an assumption which should be clearly stated so as to increase the accuracy and interpretation of results.


