The topic also concerns the development of new catalysts' synthetic routes for the abovementioned catalytic reactions, as well as the establishment of structure–property relationships for the understanding of the reaction mechanisms. Moreover, studies dealing with the use of physical activation methods (e.g., ultrasound, microwave, ball-milling, non-thermal plasma, UV, electrochemistry) either for selective and total catalytic reactions or for the design of N-ligands with improved characteristics and catalytic properties in view of the topic of this Special Issue are also very welcome.



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
