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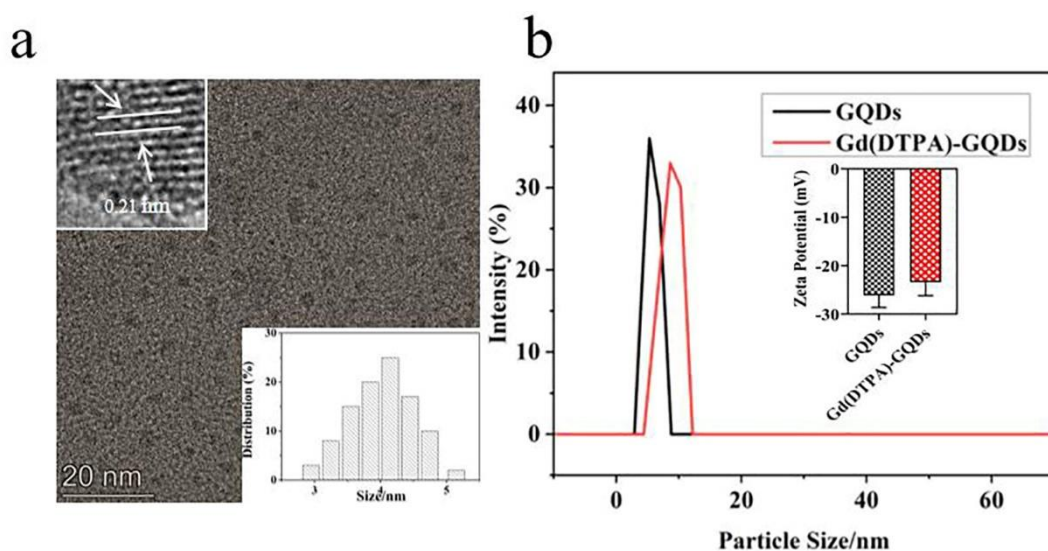

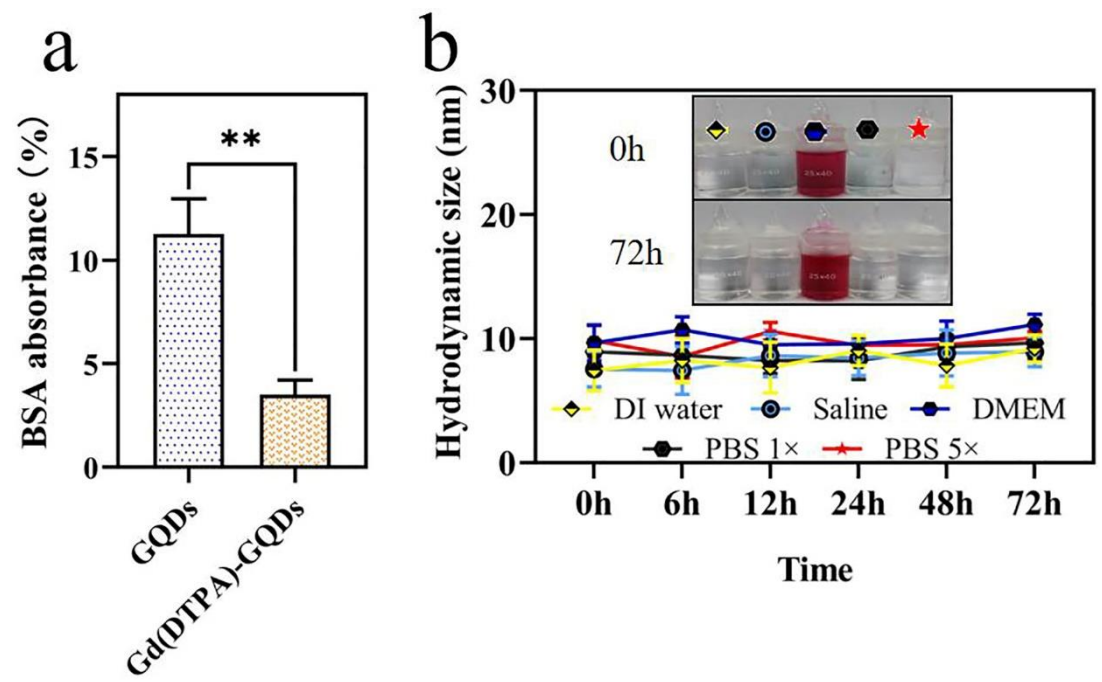

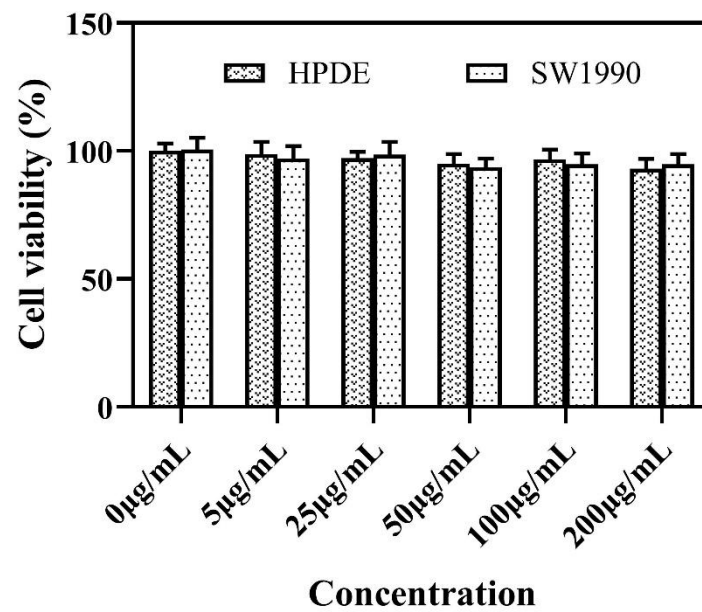


Figure S3. Cytotoxicity against HPDE cells and SW1990 cells after incubation with different concentrations of various GQDs for 24 h.

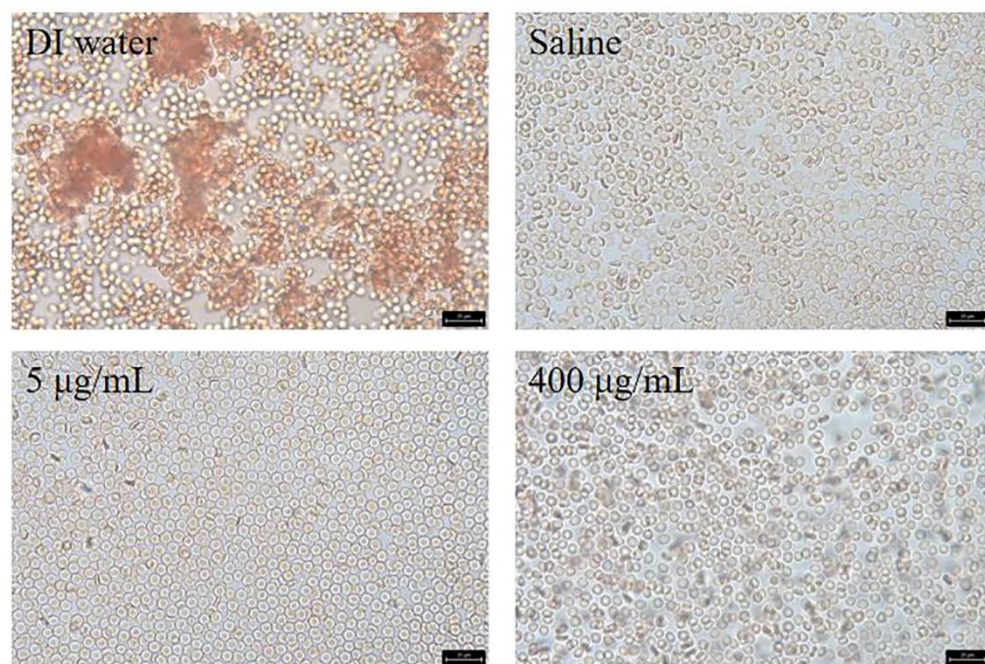

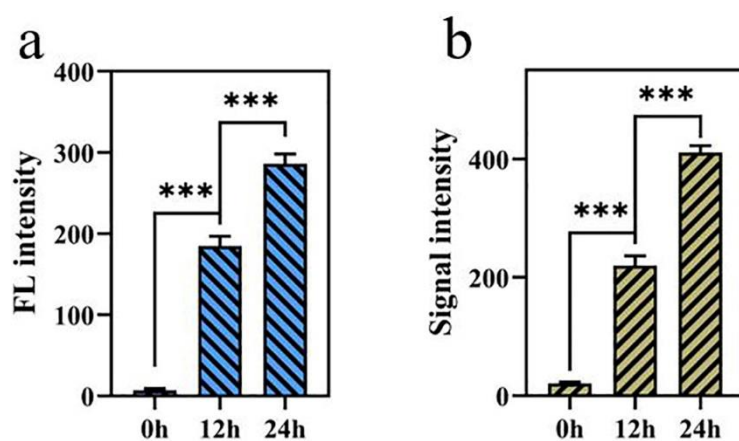
