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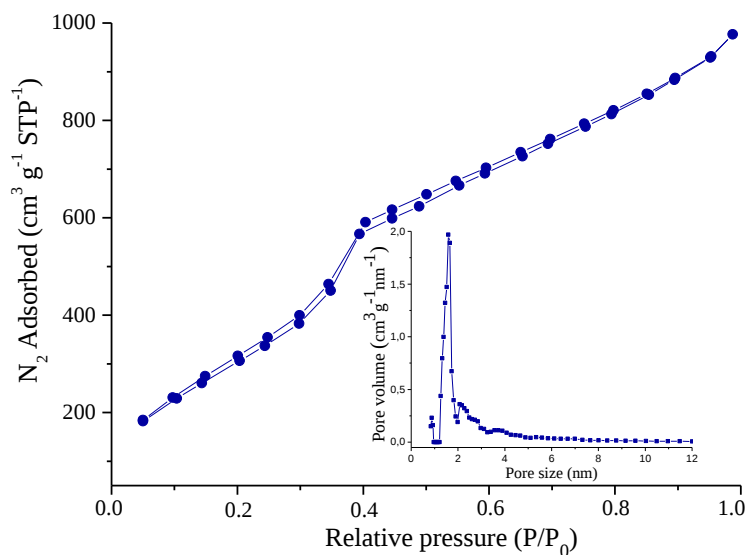


Figure S1. Adsorption/desorption isotherms of silica MCM-41-AC.

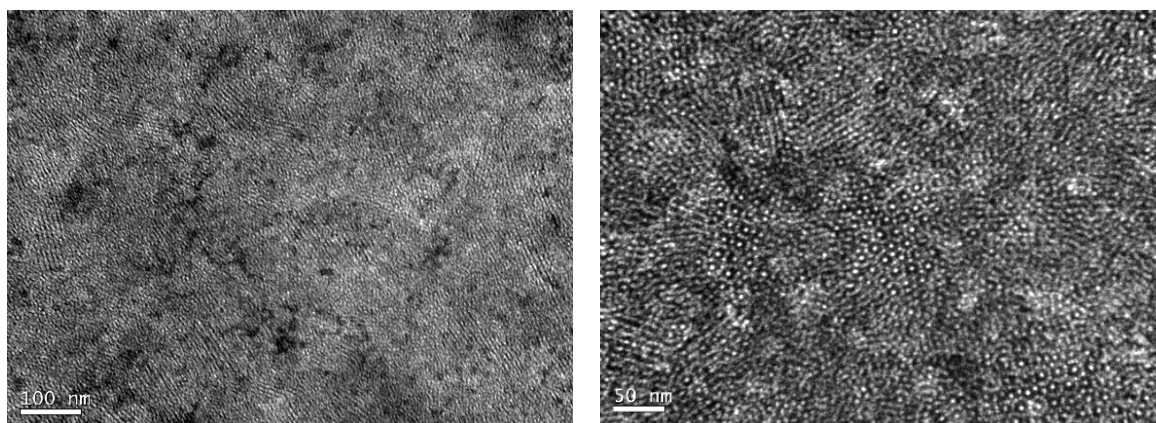


Figure S2. Transmission Electron Microscopy of MCM-41-AC.
