Glasgow Outcome Scale-Extended (GOSE)

GOSE 8-point scale	Domain	Criteria
1 = Dead		Dead
2 = Vegetative state	Consciousness	
3 = Lower severe disability	Function in Home	Unable to look after themselves for 8 h
4 = Upper severe disability	Function in Home Function Outside the Home	Unable to look after themselves for 24 h OR Unable to shop OR Unable to travel
5 = Lower moderate disability	Work/Study Social and Leisure Activities Family and Friendships	Unable to work/study OR Unable to participate OR Constant problems
6 = Upper moderate disability	Work Social and Leisure Activities Family and Friendships	Reduced work capacity OR Participate much less OR Frequent problems
7 = Lower good recovery	Social and Leisure Activities Family and Friendships Symptoms	Participate a bit less OR Occasional problems OR Some symptoms affecting daily life
8 = Upper good recovery		No problems
