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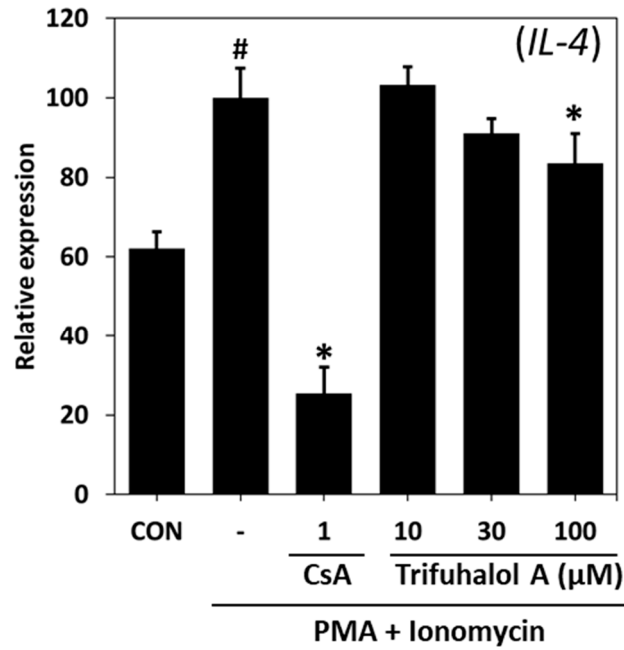
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Supplementary Figure S1. Effects of trifluhalol A on IL-4 production. Representative data of qPCR analysis of IL-4 mRNA normalized to GAPDH in PMA/ionomycin (PI)-induced RBL-2H3 cells. RBL-2H3 cells were treated with trifluhalol A in combination with PMA (50 $\mu\text{g/ml}$)/ionomycin (0.1 μM) for 8 h to measure IL-4 expression. Each bar represents the mean \pm S.D. of duplicates. # $P < 0.05$ vs. control; * $P < 0.05$ vs. PI-induced group. CsA; 1 μM of cyclosporine A.
