

Supplementary material 1: Results of the exploratory factor analysis

In the calibration sample, the Kaiser-Meyer-Olkin criterion was 0.925 (Bartlett Test $p \leq 0.001$). The exploratory factor analysis results in two factors, factor 1 explaining 36.4% and factor 2 explaining 25.4% of the variance, respectively. Table S1 shows the component matrix with Varimax rotation sorted in descending order.
