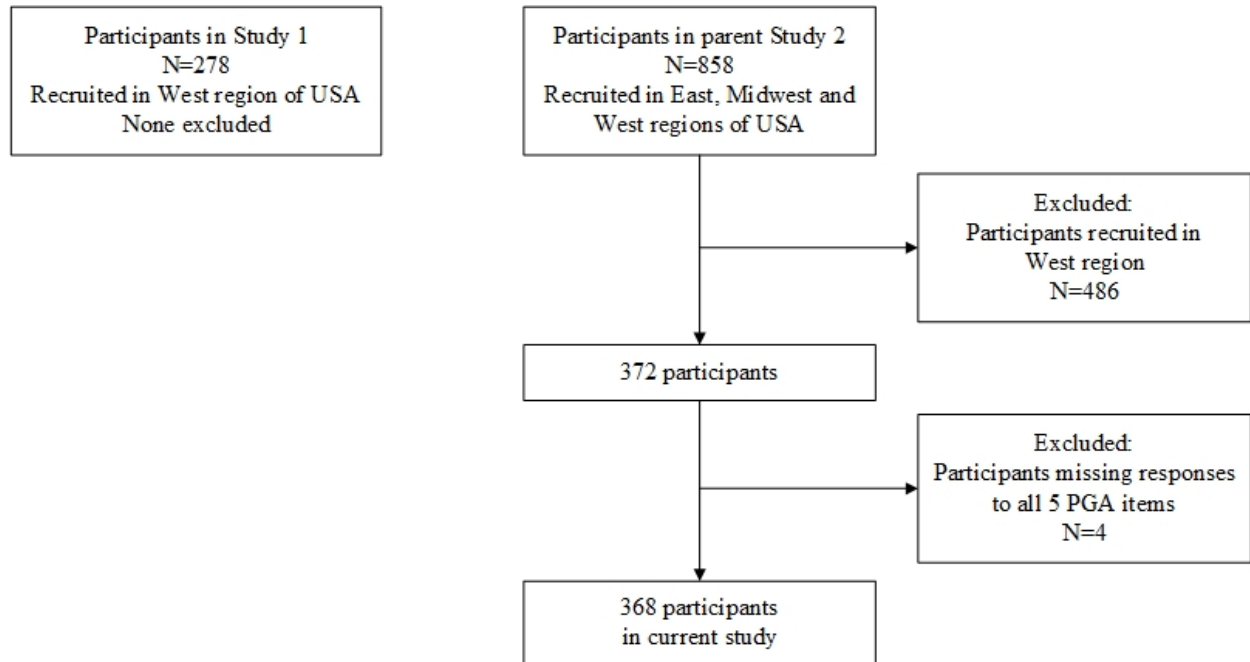


Supplementary Figure 1: Flowchart of participant inclusion
