

Supplementary **Table S1**: Cherries Checklist for Web Surveys

DESIGN: The target population is represented by IBD patients—convenience sample

IRB: Ethical review and approval were waived for this study, due to the fact that this was only a survey on IBD patients submitted to remote monitoring

DATA information: The patients were informed via e-mail about the purpose of the study

DATA PROTECTION: No personal information were stored.

DEVELOPMENT AND PRE-TESTING: The survey was developed by using the SIBDQ (to evaluate the QoL) and the IBDSI (to evaluate symptoms as patients' reported outcomes). All patients sent by email results of blood tests: Erythrocyte Sedimentation Rate (ESR), C-Reactive Protein (CRP), complete blood count (CBC), faecalcalprotectin, ferritin, serum iron. Harvey Bradshaw Index and Mayo Ulcerative Colitis score were calculated by the treating physicians.

RECRUITMENT PROCESS

OPEN vs CLOSE survey: CLOSE survey, since the patients were contacted via e-mail personally
