


Figure S1. Variance inflation factors (VIFs) of the multiple linear regressions shown in Figure 12. VIF is a widely used indicator for measuring the multicollinearity in multiple linear regressions. Normally, $VIF > 10$ indicates severe multicollinearity, $5 < VIF < 10$ indicates weak multicollinearity, and $VIF < 5$ indicates no multicollinearity. Nearly all the VIFs in this study < 1.5 , indicating these multiple linear regressions are not affected by multicollinearity.
