Figure S3 shows the Ragone plot of MnPO<sub>4</sub>·H<sub>2</sub>O nanowire/graphene oxide material with ultrahigh specific power, which is close to conventional solid state. However, it is average in specific energy compared with some reported similar phosphates [1,2].
