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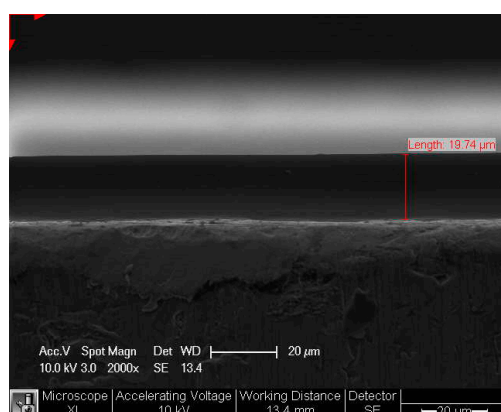


Figure S1. Thickness of hydrogel coating H1 determined using ESEM.

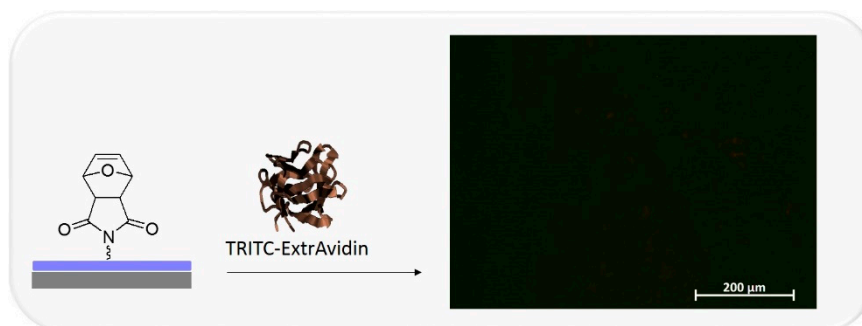


Figure S2. Control experiment with non-biotinylated H2 and related fluorescence microscopy image.
