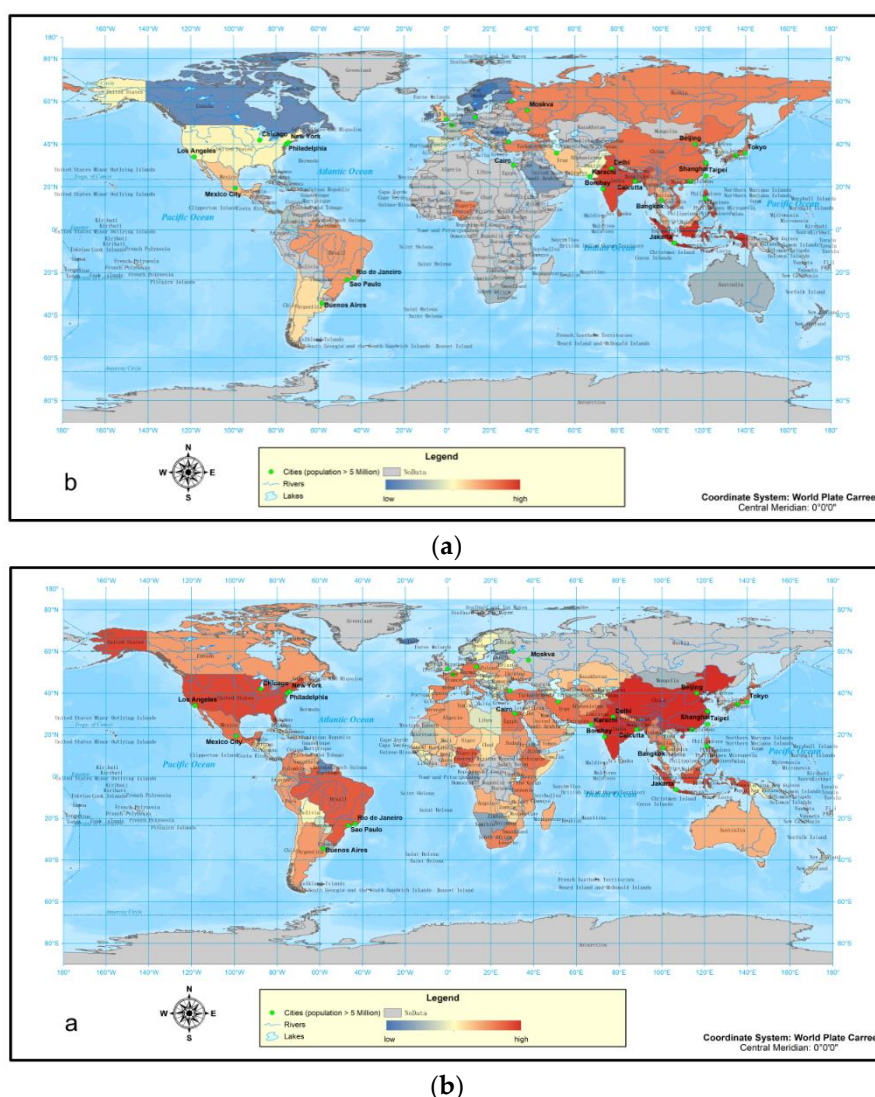


Figure S1. (a) Demand for masks in countries around the world (data sources: [21]); (b) emissions of masks in various coastal countries (data sources: [22]).
