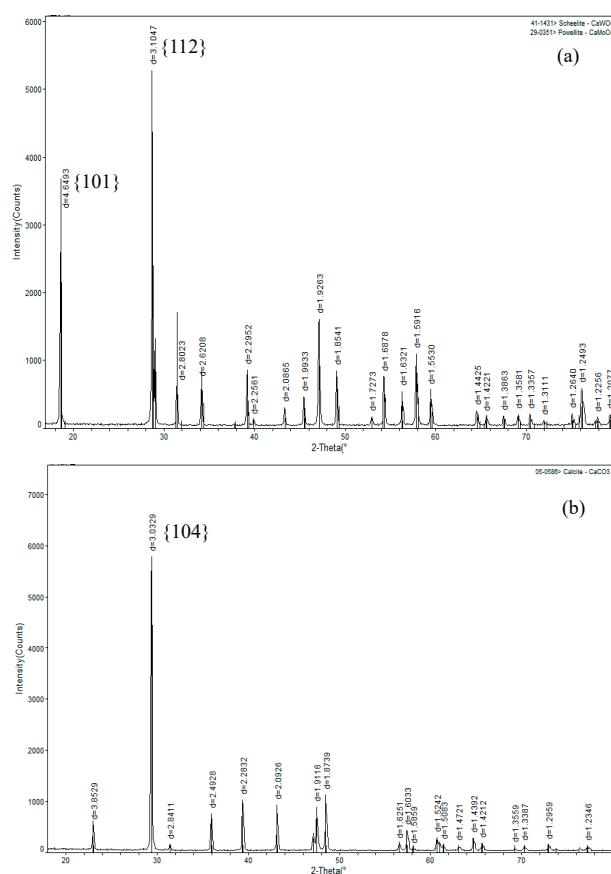


Figure S1 XRD of pure scheelite (a) and calcite (b)

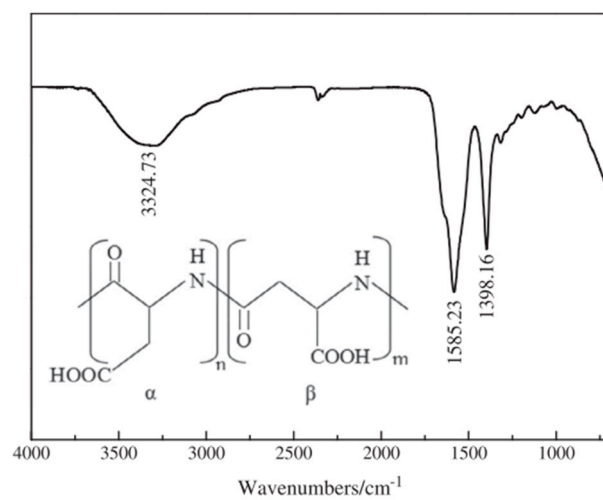


Figure S2. Infrared spectra of PASP
