BEHAVIOR	DEFINTION
PHYSICAL ACTIVITY – Point Time Sampling	
walk	Actively moving at a slow pace.
run	Actively moving at a quick pace.
climb up	Actively climbing up.
climb down	Actively climbing down.
AGONISTIC-- Continuous Sampling	
chase	To run after another individual on more than 2 meters to make it run away and/or bite/hit/grab it.
bite	To bite another individual.
hit	To hit another individual with any limb
grab	To catch and hold in a hand a bunch of fur of another one to retain it.
push	To push with hand or body to make an individual moving away.
lunge	To make a short run (< 2 meters) or a jump toward an individual (warning that could lead to an aggressive behavior.)
scream	Noisy scream vocalization.
flight	To run away in response to another's approach/aggression.
crouch	To press body on the ground, 4 limbs flexed in response to another's approach/aggression.
protection	An individual threatened or attacked by another approaches
seeking	and contacts a third individual.
