

Table S1: The detailed scoring system

<i>Variables</i>	<i>Specific features</i>
<i>Clinical</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - symptom duration > 7 days - local Murphy sign - concomitant hematological disease - overweight / obesity - previous lithotherapy
<i>Ultrasounds</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - multiple calculi - sonographic Murphy sign - sliding calculus - pericholecystic fluid - biliary tree calculi - gallbladder wall thickening > 3 mm - gallstone > 3 mm - gallbladder distension - biliary tree calculi/biliary tree dilatation - hepato/splenomegaly - lymph nodes in the hepatic pedicle
<i>Surgical</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gallbladder adhesions >50% - gallbladder distension - gallbladder unable to grasp - stone impact - signs of inflammation - time to identify cystic artery/duct > 90min
<i>Histological</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ulcers and/or erosion - Inflammatory cell infiltration - Fibrosis - Adenomyosis - Reactive epithelial hyperplasia - Epithelial atrophy - Parietal atrophy - Intramural microlitiasis - Intestinal metaplasia

For each parameter, a dichotomous variable was created (0 = absence; 1 = presence); for histological features, a severity grade (1-2-3) was further added
