- Number of submissions received: 45 in CFP, 9 in late-news poster-only call.

- Acceptance rate (number of submissions accepted/number of submissions received): 15% Oral Papers; 91% Overall Abstract acceptance; 49% Abstract to Proceedings Acceptance
