

Table S1 shows the distribution of individuals according to OHIP-14 dimensions .Considering the potential impact in quality of life indicated by the association of the most negative answers (“often” and “all the time”), it could be observed that physical pain (5.8%) and psychological discomfort (5.8%) were the most frequently occurring OHIP-14 dimensions (Table 2).
