Psychiatrist	Severe dementia, Severe psychiatric symptoms	Dementia, Depression, Anxiety, Apathy, ICD, DDS
Therapist	High risk of falling, High dependence on ADL	Freezing of gait, Severe postural instability, Abnormal posture of the trunk
Nurse	No caregivers	Uncooperative caregivers, Lack of therapeutic goals, Gap between expectation and reality
Dentist		Dysphagia, Aspiration risk
