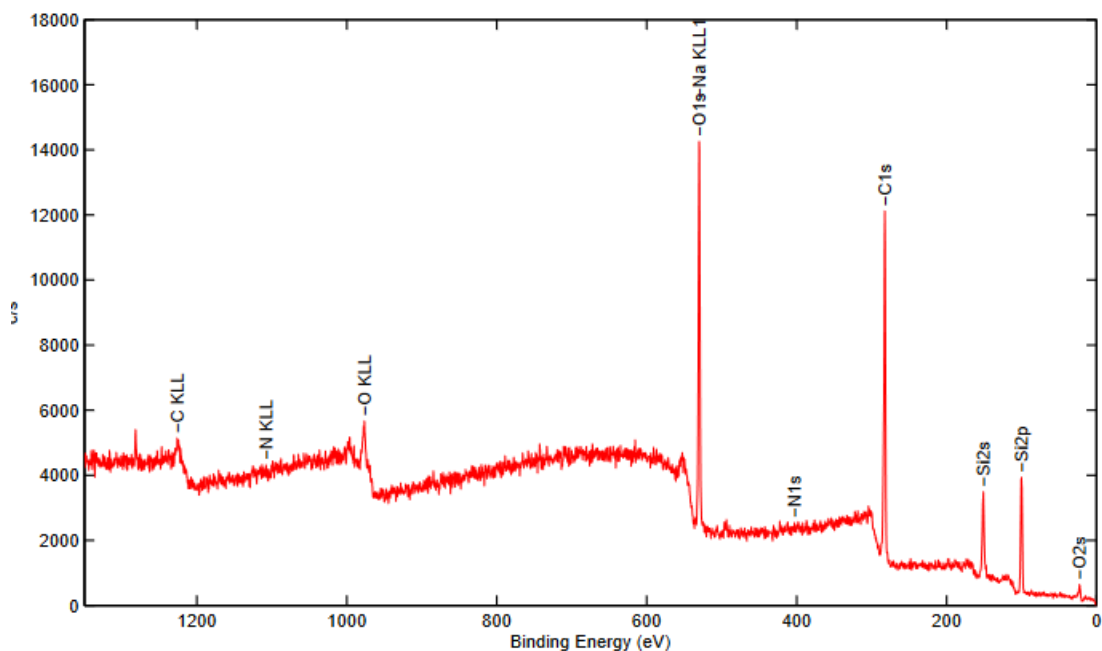


Figure S1. Survey XPS spectrum of gentamicine modified C₆₀ fullerene (60FGG).

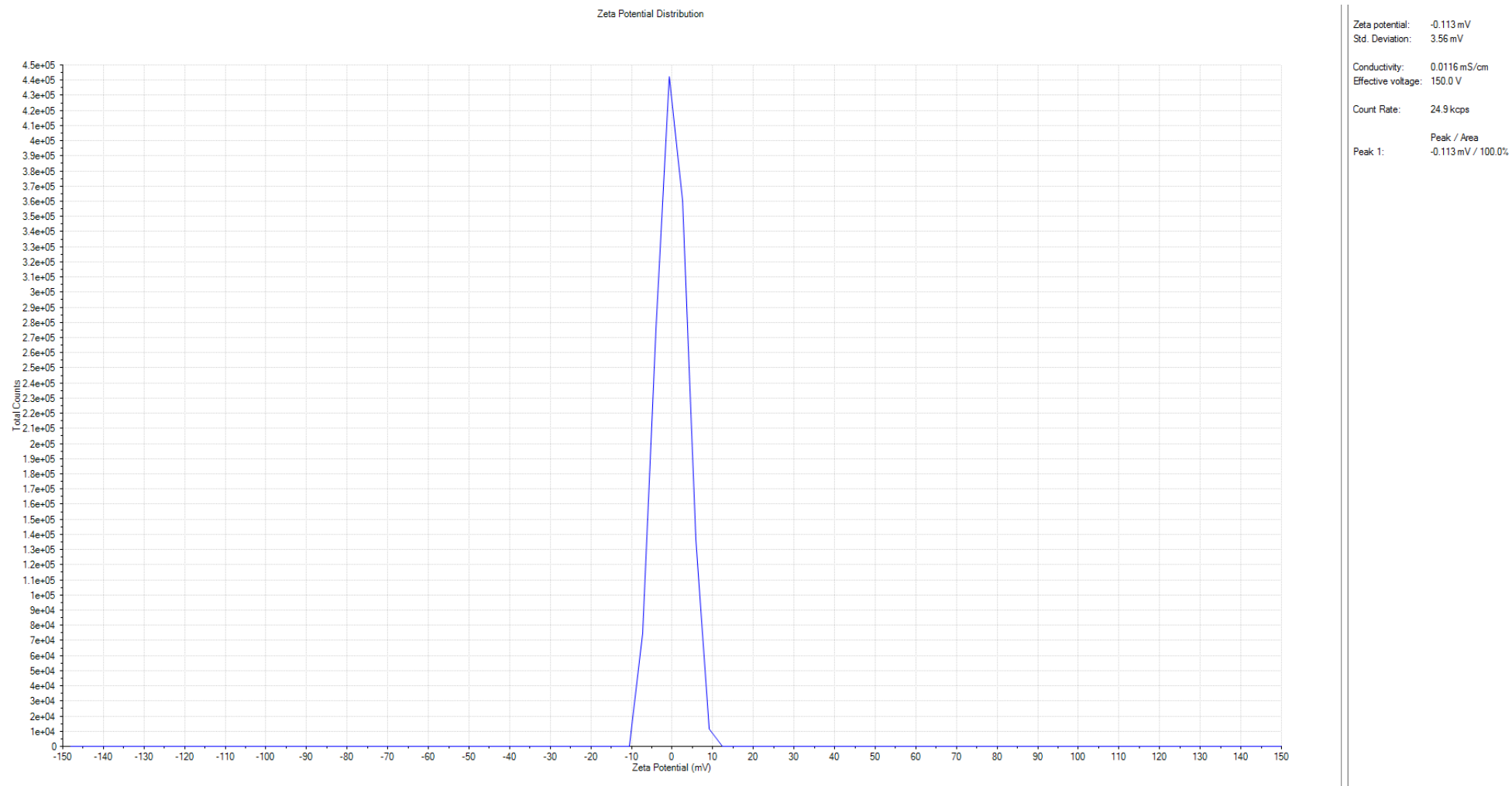


Figure S2. Zeta potential measurements of C₆₀ fullerene (60F).

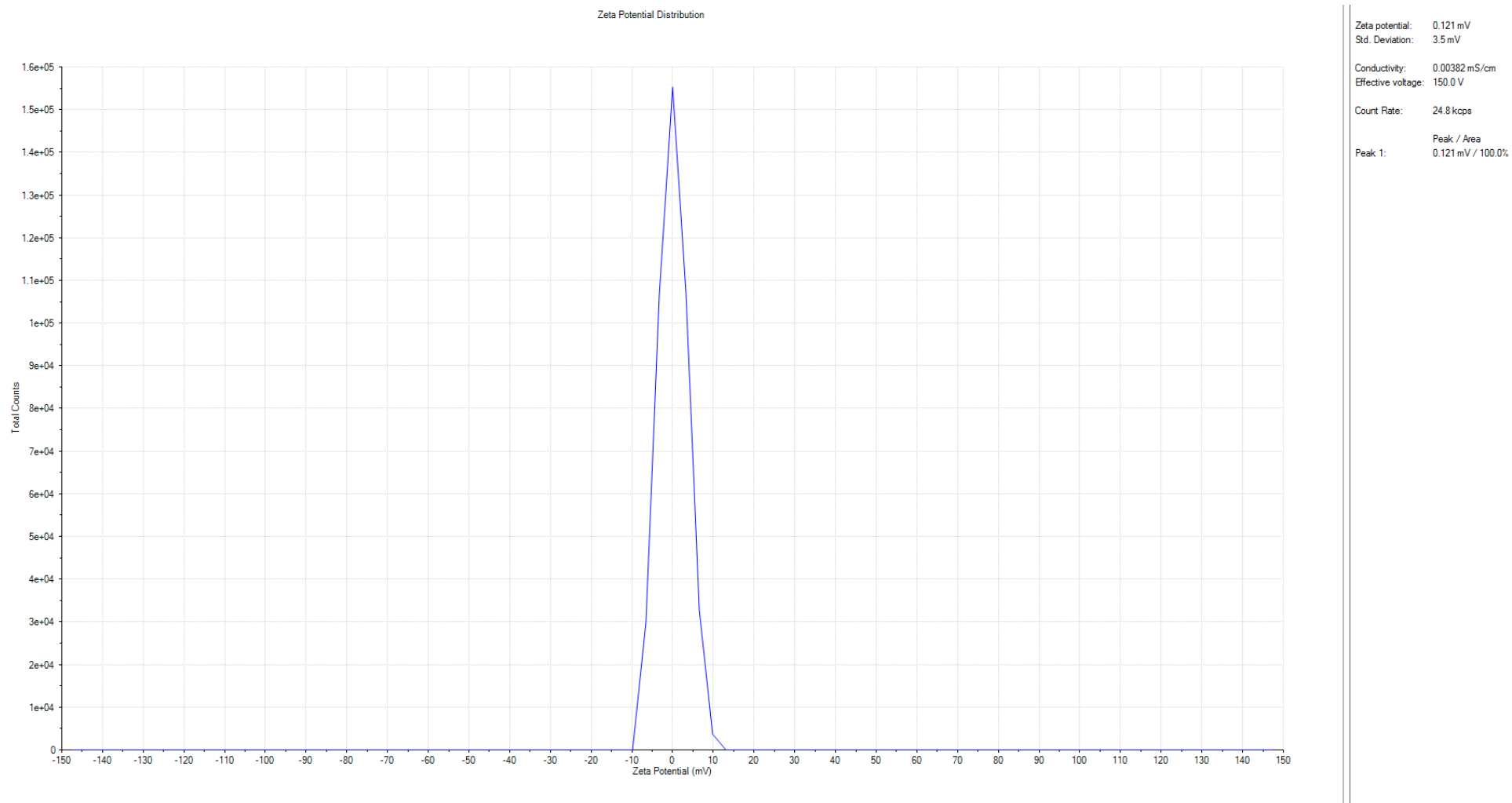


Figure S3. Zeta potential measurements of gentamicin functionalized C₆₀ fullerene (60FGG).
