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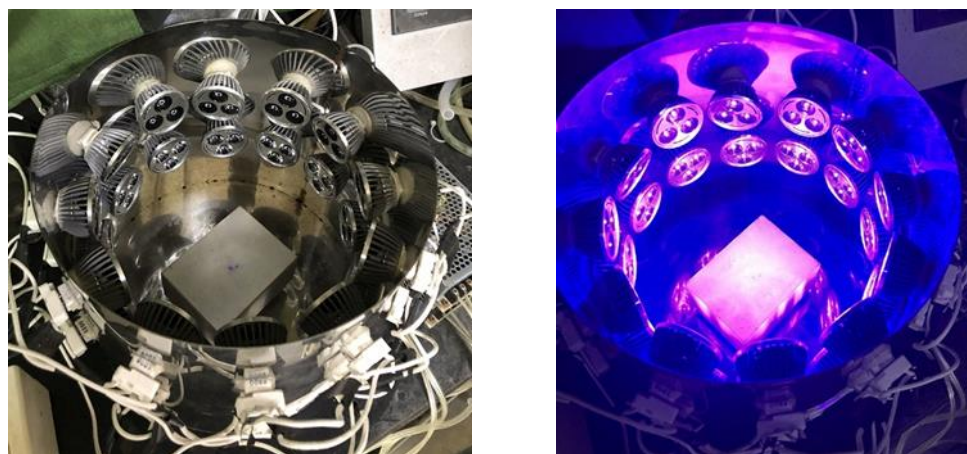


Figure S1. The setups for violet LED irradiation to generate quasi-spherical Ag NPs. The cabinet, containing 24 LEDs with 405 nm wavelengths, was used for uniform light intensity (0.01 W/cm^2), surrounding a 50-mL reaction vial. The LED lamps were turned off (**left**), and on (**right**).

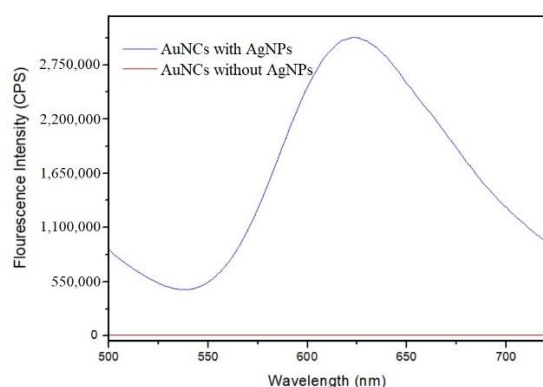

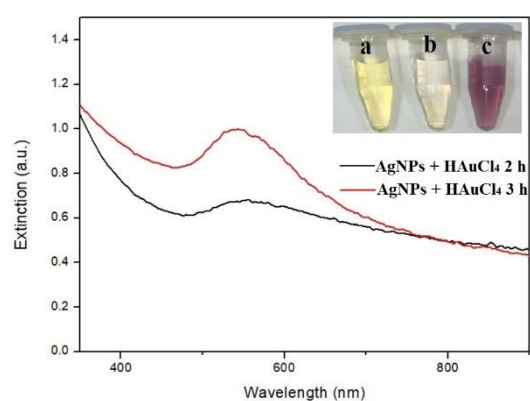

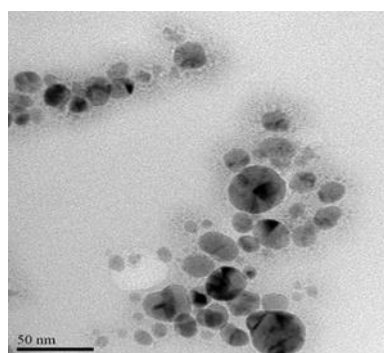


Figure S4. TEM images of quasi-spherical Ag NPs after they were mixed with GSSG.
