Figure S4: Detailed information on dengue virus proteins identified by MS/MS in the supernatant of BHK-21 cells transfected with different DNA vaccines. For every gel fraction analyzed, we have shown: 1) the protein sequence coverage and all identified peptides; 2) The best MS/MS spectrum identifying each dengue virus protein (top 1 primary score).
