## 2019 AGRONOMY AWARD YOUNG INVESTIGATOR

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of the field of Agronomy.
2. No more than 10 years since conferral of a PhD degree (by 30 April 2019).

List of Documents for Application:

1. A Curriculum Vitae, including a complete list of publications and conference activities.
2. A description of the nominee's major research contributions over the last 5 years.
3. The nominee should include a brief summary (one page) of their research interests, accomplishments, and expected benefits from attending the conference/congress.
4. A letter of recommendation from a supervisor.

The award will consist of:

1. A certificate;
2. An honorarium of 2000 Swiss Francs (CHF);
3. A 20% discount for publishing two papers in *Agronomy* in the future.
