The journal ranks 11/61 (Q1) in the category 'Agriculture, Dairy & Animal Science' and 29/141 (Q1) in 'Veterinary Sciences.'

Author Benefits

Open Access: free for readers, with article processing charges (APC) paid by authors or their institutions.

High Visibility: indexed by the Science Citation Index Expanded (Web of Science) from Vol. 5 (2015), Zoological Record (Web of Science) and Scopus. Citations available in PubMed, full-text archived in PubMed Central.

Rapid Publication: manuscripts are peer-reviewed and a first decision provided to authors approximately 15 days after submission; acceptance to publication is undertaken in 2.8 days (median values for papers published in this journal in the first half of 2020).
