Message from the Guest Editors

In this Special Issue, we would like to offer articles on phosphite-containing preparations as immunity triggers and biostimulants that facilitate the regeneration of plants after unfavourable stress factors such as frost, drought, and damage caused by the improper application of plant protection products and regeneration after the harmful effects of diseases and pests. Some topics of interest include soil conditioners using waste materials such as phosphogypsum as a source of phosphorus and sulfur; as well as silicon-based formulations to improve the water balance of plants, which is particularly important during periods of drought. We are also interested in receiving studies on the in vitro evaluation of the antioxidant effect of flavonoids isolated from plants and produced as aqueous methanol extracts, such as coumestacillin, penduletin or jeceidin. In this Special Issue, we invite the research community in the field to contribute original scientific articles. Comprehensive review articles will also be accepted. We are looking forward to your contributions!
