Message from the Guest Editors

This Special Issue mainly aims to honor the extraordinary works of professional scholars or experts who attend the 4th Central European Symposium on Thermophysics (CEST2022) in Olomouc, Czech Republic. It provides discussions on specialized topics from academic and industrial research and exchange invaluable experiences in the field of thermophysical properties in a broad sense. The conference papers accepted for potentially publishing in the journal must be original and will be referred to a high standard. They may include new research findings, together with developments in design methodology and fabrication techniques. Conferences must be significantly extended in length at least by 50% in the Applied Sciences template. Hence, compared to the original conference paper, it must contain new results not described in the conference paper and not published elsewhere so far. All manuscripts are thoroughly refereed through a single-blind peer-review process.

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As the world of science becomes ever more specialized, researchers may lose themselves in the deep forest of the ever increasing number of subfields being created. This open access journal Applied Sciences has been started to link these subfields, so researchers can cut through the forest and see the surrounding, or quite distant fields and subfields to help develop his/her own research even further with the aid of this multi-dimensional network.

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
