2020 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND PhD STUDENTS

Candidate Requirements:

- The applicant must be a PhD student or a postdoctoral fellow;
- The candidate should provide an active registration certificate at a university or a letter from the supervisor on his/her scholar status;
- The applicant must present his/her own original work as an oral or poster presentation at the conference for which he/she has been awarded.

Required Application Documents:

- An abstract that will be submitted to the conference being held in 2020 (conference format is acceptable);
- An updated Curriculum Vitae;
- A justification letter for the choice of the conference and costs;
- A letter of support from their mentor/institution for the remaining cost if applicable.

The Awards will consist of **800 Swiss Francs** for each awardee and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. The awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/ presentation and meeting badge after attending the conference.
