2019 TRAVEL AWARDS FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS

Candidates' Requirements:

- Assistant professors, postdoctoral fellows, or their equivalents in atmospheric sciences.
- Age under 38 years (by 31 December 2018).
- Will take part in an international conference in 2019 (oral presentation or poster).
- Applicants are asked to submit the following documents:
 - 1. An outline of current and future work (500 words).
 - 2. A Curriculum Vitae, including a complete list of publications.
 - 3. The conference you plan to attend and the abstract that will be submitted.
 - 4. A letter of recommendation from a supervisor or PI.
- Awardees are asked to acknowledge support from the journal Atmosphere in their presentations.

The Award will consist of 800 Swiss Francs.
