Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that *Batteries* is now inviting nominations for 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigators in recognition of their excellence in different areas of research on battery technology and materials. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Andreas Jossen.

The Prize:

- 1000 CHF (Swiss Francs) for winner;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Batteries* after peer review before the end of 31 December 2023;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must be under 35 years of age or have received their PhD no more than 8 years prior to 31 December 2021;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of battery technology and materials;
- Candidates must be nominated by their supervisor(s), research director, or department head.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- A copy of a birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: January 2022;
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022;
- Winners announced: 28 February 2023.
