Message from the Guest Editors

Family interaction is central to children's social development, shaping their cognitive, emotional, and behavioral adaptation throughout life. Recent research has shifted from a static, problem-oriented view to a dynamic, process-focused approach, exploring mechanisms of development through interaction—such as parent-child coordination, emotional exchange, and joint attention—alongside multi-level dynamics like neural synchrony and physiological covariation. This Special Issue invites studies examining how family interactions (e.g., parent-child, marital, parenting, emotion socialization) influence children's social development and mental health (e.g., emotion regulation, self-perception, school adaptation, relationships). We particularly encourage research integrating behavioral and cognitive-neural perspectives and adopting bidirectional or systemic approaches. Empirical, longitudinal, multi-level, and experimental studies, as well as high-quality metaanalyses and reviews, are welcome to advance theoretical and empirical understanding in this field.
