## Message from the Guest Editors

- Scaling up interventions to group or population level;
- The role of \*type 1 and type 2 processes in health behavior (\*dual-process theory of Evans 2003; Thaler and Sunstein, 2008; Kahneman 2011);
- Health economic approaches to prevention;
- Analysis of intervention type (awareness and literacy, nudges, regulation, etc.);
- Considerations of individual-level interventions vs. system-level changes.
