Osteoarthritis (OA) is one of the most common orthopaedic diseases affecting lower extremity joints, especially the knee and hip. There is currently no cure for OA. Pharmaceutical and non- pharmaceutical therapies are often recommended for patients with earlier stages of OA. While joint arthroplasty including partial and total knee arthroplasty (TKA) and total hip arthroplasty (THA) arthroplasty is a popular choice for end-stage OA, post-surgery rehabilitation remains a challenge to the patients and clinicians. This Special Issue of "Biomechanics of Orthopaedic Rehabilitation" focuses on advances in biomechanics of rehabilitations related to joint arthroplasty and OA.
