This prize will be given to two young investigators in recognition of her/his excellence in the field of biomedicine. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Shaker A. Mousa.

The prize:

Each winner will receive the following:

- CHF 1000;
- A certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have a Ph.D. degree;
- Must be below 35 years of age by 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the research on human health and disease, the discovery and characterization of new therapeutic targets and therapeutic strategies, and the research of naturally driven biomedicines, pharmaceuticals, and biopharmaceutical products;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

Open for nominations: 1 January 2022; Nomination deadline: 30 June 2022; Winners announcement: 30 September 2022.
