We are pleased to announce that *Biomedicines* is now welcoming nominations for the *Biomedicines* 2022 Early-Career Women Award. This prize will be awarded to one female investigator in recognition of her excellence in the field of biomedicines. All nominations will be assessed by the Journal Award Committee, which will be led by the Section Editor-in-Chief, Dr. Veronique Baud. The winner will be announced on 31 January 2023.

Prizes:

- CHF 1000;
- Invitation to publish one paper free of charge in *Biomedicines* in 2023, following peer review;
- A certificate.

Award Terms and Conditions:

- Nominees should be early career researchers, with untenured positions, who completed their Ph.D. no more than 15 years prior to 31 December 2022;
- Nominees must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the field of biomedicines;
- Nominees can only be nominated for one award at a time. Please do not submit nominations to this award and *Biomedicines* 2022 Young Investigator Award simultaneously.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate or medical certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior researchers.

Schedule:

- Nominations open: 31 March 2022;
- Nomination deadline: 30 November 2022;
- Winner announcement: 31 January 2023.
