Pheochromocytoma and Paraganglioma (PPGL) are rare neuroendocrine characterized by catecholamine secretion which are responsible for alterations in basically all organ systems. Undiagnosed and untreated PPGLs are associated with high morbidity and mortality. Recent years lead to significant progress in the genetics, pathogenesis, and metabolomics of PPGLs, which, in turn, allows for the development of novel diagnostic and therapeutic methods. The diagnosis and treatment of metastatic PPGL represents a major health concern and is the main focus of researchers.
